MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
MARCH 23, 2009

A special meeting of the Everly City Council was held on Monday, March 23, 2009 in City Hall. This meeting was called for the purpose of hiring personnel and setting wages and benefits. Mayor Bud Meyer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.. Present were Jeannett Trojahn, Sheryl Kahl, Ron Thompson, Steve Rank, and Cathy Adkins.

A motion made by Rank, second by Adkins, to hire Kate Rice as the new city clerk at \$12.00 per hour. Voting aye: all. Nay: none. She will start after she has finished out her 2 week notice at present job. Council also reviewed job description/duties. Kate will be going to clerking school in July.

Council reviewed wages of all employees A motion made by Rank and second by Adkins, to increase Janice Thompson hourly wage by \$1.29 as she will be training the new clerk in April and to increase the wages of Harden, Stockdale and Maranell by two (2) percent. Voting aye: Trojahn, Kahl, Rank and Adkins. Nay: Thompson.

Employee insurance compensation was also discussed. Some council members thought we should investigate providing Health Insurance for employees instead of giving each employee a set amount to purchase their own. Council decided to table and revisit this matter at a later time.

Motion by Rank, second by Thompson, to adjourn.
The meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
